## Other Options for Taking the Final Exam

Students may take the final earlier and/or at an alternate location PROVIDED the professor is notified at least one week in advance of the planned test date. Advance notice is needed so that the final is available when and where it will be needed.

- Shelton Test Proctor; appointments with the proctor are required.
