Group Testing Sessions

Students are automatically assigned to these group testing sessions.

- TEST 1: Thursday October 29 from 5:30 pm to 7:30 pm in ST-201, Bremerton campus
- TEST 2: Thursday November 30 from 5:30 pm to 7:30 pm in ST-201, Bremerton campus

Other Options for Taking Test 1 and Test 2

Students may take these tests earlier and/or at alternate locations PROVIDED the professor is notified at least one week in advance of the planned test date. Advance notice is needed so that tests are available when and where students plan to take them.

- Bremerton Testing Center HSS 222; appointments are not needed except for Access Services accommodations.
- Shelton Test Proctor; appointments with the proctor are required.
- Another college's testing center or a military education center
Students are required to make all arrangements and pay any required fees to the facility. Email the professor with the name of the facility, the name of the proctor, and the proctor's email address.

Note: The final exam is taken online, away from campus, and is due Thursday December 14.
